4. Minutes of the last meeting

Minutes were approved

5. Questionnaire

Documents from the DDDC Local Plan Advisory Committee Appendix 2 & 3 which had been published on the 18th Jan 2016 were discussed. These documents comprised of 'Site Assessments' for two plots of ground SHLAA184 & SHLAA219 and a map. These sites had previously been designated as of 'Low Sensitivity' in the 'Landscape Sensitivity Study'. Both plots were described as 'undevelopable' in the 'Site Assessments' due to access and heritage issues.

A discussion followed regarding the questionnaire which resulted in changing some of the questions in light of the new information.

Nick suggested that the focus should now be more on the style of building.

In the 'Hierarchical Study' it was revealed that out of a possible 24 villages earmarked for development, Kirk Ireton was 23rd with a maximum requirement of three new houses in the next 20 years to fulfil the Derbyshire Dales quota.

The questionnaire was then read out question by question and suggestions made where it was felt that alterations were needed. It was decided that R Neville, N Delves and J Hall should write the alterations and submit the document to be piloted and approved by the next meeting of Feb 24th 2016.

Maurice Coey will be asked if he could design the layout and print the questionnaire.
